



FY 2026 Community Project Funding Disclosures:

For Fiscal Year 2026, the House Appropriations Committee accepted Member requests for Community Project Funding (CPF) in appropriations bills. Community Projects Funding is a congressional provision that directs funds toward a specific project within a community. Each Member was limited to no more than 15 Community Project Funding requests across all subcommittees and there is no guarantee that all requested projects will be funded. Projects are restricted to a limited number of federal funding streams, and only state and local governments and eligible non-profit entities are permitted to receive funding.

Beltway Northeast Connector Design Engineering

- \$5,200,000 for Design Engineering for the Beltway Northeast Connector in Decatur.
- The entity to receive funding for this project is Macon County, located at Macon County Office Building, 141 South Main Street, Suite 501, Decatur, IL 62523.
- The funding would be used for design engineering for the next segment of the Beltway Northeast connector in Decatur.
