Dear Congresswoman Glusenkamp Perez,

Clark County Sheriff's Office is writing this letter to support Clark County Jail Services application for a 2026 Community Project funding request for architectural design of a local indoor public safety range and training center.

As the oldest law enforcement organization in Washington, the mission of Clark County Sheriff's Office is to protect and safeguard our community. CCSO provides critical public safety services in the local community with 165 sworn deputies all of whom are firearms qualified. CCSO is responsible for direct patrol jurisdiction of unincorporated Clark County covering 512 square miles, 251,890 residents and in 2024, responded to 70,449 calls for service.

In addition to patrol, CCSO facilitates specialized law enforcement services including marine patrol, SWAT, a K9 Unit, cold cases as well as civil services including public disclosure, identification, civil processes, criminal records and warrants, cadet and explorer programs, the Children's Justice Center and body worn cameras.

If funding is awarded, CCSO commits to ongoing collaboration with CCJS and other local law enforcement partners to participate in architectural design efforts to create a localized indoor public safety range and training center to provide a cost effective, long-term solution for training and compliance with state firearms certification requirements.
