Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Eaton Boulevard Improvement Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Battle Ground, located at 109 SW 1st Street, Battle Ground, WA 98604. The funding would be used to transform 0.5 miles along SW Eaton Boulevard into a safe, complete street for all users. The approximately half-mile section of SW Eaton Boulevard between SW 20th and SR 503 is a narrow, two-lane road without any pedestrian or bicycle facilities and with open ditches on each side. This is one of the city's highest accident locations.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the proposed improvements to Eaton Boulevard would dramatically improve roadway safety for all users, increase active access for vulnerable users to other critical services and destinations in other parts town, and increase freight mobility throughout the City of Battle Ground.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133.
