Improvements include widening existing sidewalks, moving utilities underground, widening the street, and expanding opportunities for parking. In addition, the Main Street Revitalization project would also include improvements to Fairground Park, home of the Battle Ground Events Center, the City's award-winning skatepark, and baseball/softball fields.
