Dear Leader Thune and Minority Leader Schumer,

We kindly request that you include both House Democrats and Republicans in the legislative process leading to the promised health care reform vote in December. Bipartisan engagement across both chambers will be essential to crafting a health care proposal that can pass and be signed into law.

On November 1, with the start of the open enrollment period, millions of Americans saw just how much their health insurance premium costs will spike next year. Millions will lose their health care coverage because they will no longer be able to afford it.

As you know, those who rely on the expiring Affordable Care Act enhanced premium tax credits (ePTCs) are facing drastic premium increases. Allowing these tax credits to lapse without a clear path forward would risk real harm to those we represent.

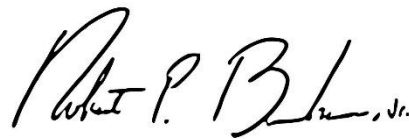

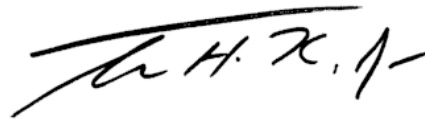

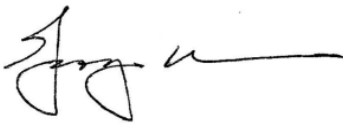
