Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for Chagrin Falls–South Russell Watermain Replacement Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Village of Chagrin Falls, located at 21 W. Washington Street, Chagrin Falls, OH 44022. The funding would be used for replacement of a 125-year-old lead-jointed watermain beneath East Washington Street, improving reliability and safety for the Chagrin Falls–South Russell Water System that serves multiple Northeast Ohio communities and critical facilities. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will eliminate lead-jointed infrastructure, reduce emergency repairs, and strengthen public health and safety.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
