I am requesting funding for the U.S. Route 20 Resurfacing Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Mentor, located at 8500 Civic Center Boulevard, Mentor, OH 44060. The funding would be used to rehabilitate approximately 2.2 miles of U.S. Route 20 in Mentor, Ohio, including roadway resurfacing, curb restoration, upgraded pavement markings, traffic signal detection improvements, and necessary utility adjustments. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will enhance safety, extend the lifespan of critical transportation infrastructure, and support economic activity along a heavily traveled regional commercial corridor.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC 133.
