
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for Explosive Ordnance Disposal Team Modernization in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Roseville Police Department located at 1051 Junction Blvd., Roseville, CA 95678. The funding would be used for acquiring a robot to examine suspected explosive evidence, a mobile command vehicle to provide integrated communications, and modern protective gear for law enforcement personnel with enhanced blast resistance. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because criminal bomb threats can shut down businesses, schools, and transportation corridors for hours. Modern explosive device disposal capabilities enable faster threat assessment and resolution, minimizing economic disruption. Rapid response and investigation protects both public safety and economic vitality.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in section 501 of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10152).
