Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for a Real Time Crime Center in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Placer County Sheriff's Office located at 175 Fulweiler Ave. Auburn, CA 95603. The funding would be used to establish a Real-Time Information Center by integrating advanced technologies such as Automatic License Plate Recognition. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because freeing up deputies and detectives from time-consuming research and data analysis tasks would allow them to focus on more critical aspects of investigations and patrol duties. This would result in faster response times, quicker arrests, and more efficient case resolutions, ultimately improving public safety in Placer County. Moreover, this time saved can be allocated to proactive crime prevention and community engagement efforts, further enhancing the Sheriff's Office's ability to serve the community.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in section 1701(b)(9) of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10381(b)(9)).
