Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for a Rural School Water & Wastewater Infrastructure Modernization Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Loomis Union School District located at 3290 Humphrey Road, Loomis, CA 95650. The funding would be used to replace aging wastewater and domestic water infrastructure at Franklin and Placer Elementary Schools in Loomis, California. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because both wastewater systems were originally installed in the 1960s and have exceeded their useful life. Franklin Elementary experienced a catastrophic septic failure in 2025 requiring emergency response. Engineering assessments confirm full system replacement is required. Placer Elementary faces similar age-related deterioration and capacity limitations. The systems serve more than 1,500 students and 150+ staff and support high community-use campuses impacting thousands of families.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in Section 306 of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act, 7 U.S. Code section 1926(a)(2).
