I am requesting funding for the Sunny Slopes Fire Station in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Mono County, California, located at PO Box 715, Bridgeport, CA 93517. The funding would be used for the construction of a fire station to provide fire protection and emergency response services.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will provide critical emergency response services to approximately 7,000 residents in an area that currently lacks nearby coverage. It will also protect critical water infrastructure operated by the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power, including the Crowley Lake reservoir and Long Valley Dam. The project has undergone significant planning and is supported by local partners, ensuring that federal funds will be used efficiently and deliver long-term public safety benefits.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized in Section 306 of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act, 7 U.S.C. § 1926(a).
