Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the Carlisle Water Tower Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Carlisle, located at 760 W. Central Avenue, Carlisle, Ohio 45005.

The funding would be used for the construction of a municipal water tower to improve water storage capacity, system reliability, and emergency response capabilities within the community.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will provide significant benefits to Carlisle residents, businesses, and public safety services. The project will serve approximately 600 existing water customers within the City's municipal water system. In addition to residential service, the system supports an estimated daytime population of approximately 3,145 individuals, reflecting workforce and visitor presence, and provides water service to approximately 250 businesses located within the community. The project also supports critical community facilities, including a local school system with an estimated student population of approximately 1,600 and approximately seven farms within the service area that rely on the system for water access. The project will also strengthen fire protection capabilities by ensuring adequate water supply and pressure for emergency response. Enhanced fire suppression capacity improves public safety, protects property, and supports the operational effectiveness of the Carlisle Fire Department.

This project has a federal nexus because it is for the purposes authorized in Section 306 of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act, 7 U.S. Code section 1926(a)(2).
