Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for Town Hall Flats Westwood Business District Mixed-Use Revitalization Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Cincinnati, located at 801 Plum Street, Cincinnati, Ohio 45202. The funding would be used for replacing vacant and blighted structured in the center of the Town Hall Flats Westwood Business District of Cincinnati with a new mixed-use building.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the project will add density to a growing business district, increasing foot traffic and customer base to sustain the economic viability of the area. The core components include 3,300 SF of ground floor commercial space and 40 mixed-income residential rental units. Of the 40 units, 16 will be affordable to households earning 80% AMI or less. Additionally, this project will create approximately 60 full-time temporary construction jobs with an annual payroll of about \$3MM.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C.5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5). I certify that I have no financial interest in this project, and neither does anyone in my immediate family.”
