Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for The Primary Care Equipment Modernization and Health Center Renovation Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is The City of Cincinnati located at 3101 Burnet Avenue, Cincinnati, Ohio, 45229. The funding would be used to modernize tools and facilities to strengthen the ability to deliver public health services. The project will also supplement a renovation of the Northside Health Center, allowing existing restrooms to become ADA accessible for the first time, providing an elevator to the building's second floor, expanding the pharmacy and adding exam rooms to increase overall capacity and improve access to care.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because this project directly supports the delivery of health care services to members of the community by providing health center tools and facility improvements. With key components of the current environment aging, these upgrades are necessary to improve reliability, strengthen cybersecurity, and reduce the risk of service disruptions.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized Under the Public Health Service Act.
