Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for The Crossroads Center for Addiction Recovery Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is The Crossroads Center, located at 2114 Reading Road Cincinnati, Ohio 45202. The funding would be used to house services provided by The Crossroads Center, supporting downtown, Walnut Hills, Mount Auburn, and Over the Rhine community members in recovery from addiction. The new building will support The Crossroads Center's services providing space for: outpatient individual counseling, group counseling, a clinic for the medication assisted treatment program and our Opioid Treatment Program, residential space for individuals who require withdrawal management from substance disorders and a minimum 30-day stay in a more structured setting providing a total of 16 female beds and 10 male beds. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it would provide treatment to those in recovery and lower costs in health care and the criminal justice system.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized Under the Public Health Service Act.
