

A MOMENT OF RECKONING

The biggest issue we face in this country is the dangerous and unprecedented concentration of wealth and power. A small group of elites have rigged our economy and politics for themselves.

- ★ At the end of 2024, there were 905 billionaires in the U.S. with \$8 trillion in wealth, or double what the 65 million lowest Americans had combined.¹
- ★ American billionaires have more wealth than double what all Americans owe on student loans, car loans, credit cards, and nearly every other type of debt combined.²
- ★ Between 1978 and 2024, CEO pay increased by over 1,000% while worker pay increased by only 26%. On average, a CEO makes more in a single day than what a worker makes in an entire year.³

The American Dream is being undermined by affordability, healthcare, and housing crises.

- ★ More than one in four Americans have \$0 saved for retirement.⁴
- ★ The cost of college has nearly tripled since the 1990s⁵; student debt has more than doubled since 2008.⁶
- ★ The cost of childcare⁷ – and the cost of having children overall – has reached a record high, while the number of people starting families has almost reached a record low.⁸
- ★ About 1 in 3 households in the U.S. have medical debt,⁹ with Americans owing a combined \$220 billion in medical debt.¹⁰
- ★ The number of first-time homebuyers is at a record low, while the cost of housing¹¹ and the average age of first-time homebuyers are at record highs.¹² Half of renters spend over 30 percent of their income on rent¹³ and eviction rates in many communities are at historic highs.¹⁴
- ★ At the same time, unprecedented corruption, voter suppression, partisan gerrymandering, and unlimited “dark” money from the super-wealthy have taken power away from us and given it to them.

NEW LEADERSHIP

- ▶ This is our moment for *BIG CHANGE*.
- ▶ It requires new leaders who have the energy and determination to take on the broken status quo and get big things done.
- ▶ Leaders who will lift us up, bring us together, reject political extremism, and take on the elites who have rigged our economic and political systems – for themselves.
- ▶ We must reject chaos, corruption, and cruelty, and instead commit to common sense, good government, and kindness.

THE REFORMS

We need a new governing document built on 10 reform bills, each focused on fixing what's been broken in America for decades.

1 WORKING FAMILIES ECONOMY ACT

Return wealth to the American people by fixing our broken economy, overhauling the tax code, and providing fully-paid for, refundable, monthly tax breaks for working families to deal with the high cost of living.

2 DRAIN THE SWAMP ACT

Ban stock trading in Congress, establish term limits, improve government services, and implement reforms to actually get rid of waste, fraud, abuse, and corruption – of any kind.

3 JOHN R. LEWIS DEMOCRACY FOR THE PEOPLE ACT

Return power to the American people and restore our democracy by banning dark money, ending voter suppression, and eliminating partisan gerrymandering once and for all.

4 BUILD BABY BUILD BILL

Pursue the largest federal investment in housing and infrastructure and get America building again.

5 HEALTHCARE FOR ALL ACT

Reverse healthcare cuts, expand coverage, establish a public option, and lower costs.

6 21ST CENTURY ANTI-CRIME ACT

Pair more cops with new laws to keep weapons out of the hands of violent people.

7 EVERY CHILD EDUCATION ACT

Invest in early education, teachers and classrooms, and the trades.

8 REAL BORDER SECURITY AND IMMIGRATION REFORM ACT

Durable border security and common-sense, humane immigration reform.

9 RESTORE PERSONAL LIBERTIES ACT

Protect civil rights and codify personal freedoms.

10 NATIONAL SECURITY AND GLOBAL LEADERSHIP ACT

Invest in our allies, restore foreign aid, and take on the enemies of freedom.





REASON TO BELIEVE

- ★ Our country's long history of overcoming adversity gives me reason to believe our Great American Moment is possible – not inevitable, but possible.
- ★ Every generation before us has faced moments of reckoning, and has had the choice of whether to give in or fight back. We've always fought back. It's what makes our country so special.
- ★ My own experience in politics also gives me reason to believe our Great American Moment is possible.
- ★ **The Cincinnati Preschool Promise:** Years ago, I set out with others to make Cincinnati the first city in the country to offer two years of quality preschool. After years of organizing, voters approved it by a record margin, and today tens of thousands of children and families benefit.
- ★ **The Social Security Fairness Act:** During my first term in Congress, we took on the Speaker of the House and forced a vote to pass the bill. It had over 300 cosponsors but hadn't moved in Congress for 25 years. Now, \$20 billion a year is going back into the pockets of our retired teachers, police officers, firefighters, and letter carriers. *(CBO)*
- ★ When you believe in something, bring people together, and refuse to give up, you can make big things happen.
- ★ It's been true for me and our country, and I believe it will be true of Our Great American Moment.
