A BILL

To require the Administrator of the Small Business Administration to submit to Congress a report on for-profit child care providers, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Child Care Small Busi-
5 ness Insight and Improvement Act of 2026”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPORT ON FOR-PROFIT CHILD CARE PROVIDERS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 120 days after the
8 date of the enactment of this Act, the Administrator of

1 the Small Business Administration shall submit to Con-
2 gress a study and report on for-profit child care providers
3 that includes—

4 (1) an assessment of the challenges and needs
5 of such providers;

6 (2) a description of the resources and support
7 that the Small Business Administration provides to
8 such providers;

9 (3) any deficiencies in the resources and sup-
10 port described under paragraph (2);

11 (4) any recommendations for legislative actions
12 necessary to address any challenges or needs faced
13 by such providers that are identified by the report
14 required in this subsection;

15 (5) an identification of the leadership needs in
16 order to successfully implement such recommenda-
17 tions; and

18 (6) the number of instances of fraud among
19 for-profit child care providers, and recommendations
20 for statutory changes necessary to prevent the mis-
21 use of any Federal funds received by for-profit child
22 care providers.

23 (b) FOR-PROFIT CHILD CARE PROVIDER DE-
24 FINED.—The term “for-profit child care provider” has the
25 meaning given the term “eligible child care provider” in

1 section 658P of the Child Care and Development Block
2 Grant Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 9858n) and is a provider
3 that operates—

4 (1) on a for-profit basis; and

5 (2) in 1 or more of the several States, territory
6 or possession of the United States, or the District of
7 Columbia.

8 (c) COMPLIANCE WITH CUTGO.—No additional
9 amounts are authorized to be appropriated to carry out
10 this Act.
