Dear Chairman Womack and Ranking Member Clyburn:

I am requesting funding for the Pass-a-Grille Way Seawall Improvements in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of St. Pete Beach, located at 155 Corey Ave, St. Pete Beach, FL 33706. The funding would be used for raising approximately 1.86 miles of seawall to an elevation of 5 feet NAVD88, installing six tidal check valves, and constructing six stormwater pump stations to reduce tidal and rainfall-driven flooding. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it addresses chronic tidal and stormwater flooding that threatens roads, homes, and essential public infrastructure, reduces long-term disaster recovery costs, and supports the economic stability of Florida's 13th Congressional District.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5).
