To amend the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act to expand eligibility for catastrophic plans.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Improved Medical Pa-
- 5 tients Affordable Care Today Act of 2025" or the "IM-
- 6 PACT Act of 2025".
