Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Cleveland Metroparks Police Vehicle Replacement for fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Cleveland Metroparks Police Department, located at 4600 Valley Parkway, Fairview Park, Ohio 44126. The funding would be used to procure and outfit 10 mission-critical police vehicles, replacing an aging and unreliable fleet that is currently costly to maintain. This investment is a fiscally responsible use of taxpayer funds that reduces long-term maintenance liabilities while ensuring the continued protection of vital green spaces, a mission supported by neighboring jurisdictions, including the Police Departments of Aurora, Lyndhurst, Rocky River, and Independence, as well as the City of Willoughby Hills.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in section 501 of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10152).
