
I am requesting \$3,300,000 in funding for Water Plant Treatment Unit Rehab Construction Phase 1 in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Coral Springs, located at 9500 West Sample Road, Coral Springs, FL 33065 with the project location taking place at 520 Ramblewood Drive, Coral Springs, FL 33071.

The City of Coral Springs currently operates a conventional lime softening water treatment plant that is approximately 58 years old. Infrastructure of this age typically experiences increased maintenance requirements, reduced reliability, and declining operational efficiency. This is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because, while the City prepares to transition to a new membrane lined water treatment system in a multiyear project, funds from this request will be used to rehabilitate the existing treatment unit so that the City's nearly 135,000 residents will still have access to potable water while the larger project unfolds.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
