
I am requesting \$778,000 in funding for Margate Public Safety Enhancements in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Margate Police Department, located at 5790 Margate Blvd Margate, FL 33063 with the project location taking place at the same location.

These strategic investments will enhance the Margate Police Department's ability to prevent crime, respond effectively to emergencies, and protect residents and visitors across their growing community. The Department is seeking support for a suite of modern, interoperable technologies designed to improve real-time situational awareness, reduce risk to officers and civilians, and strengthen investigative capabilities. The proposal is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because it advances policing technology to improve safety, investigations, and emergency response and the investments represent a forward-looking, technology-driven approach to public safety. The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes section 1701(b)(9) of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10381(b)(9)).
