
I am requesting \$1,000,000 in funding for Boca Raton Critical Erosion Prevention in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Boca Raton, located at 201 West Palmetto Park Road, Boca Raton, FL 33432 with the project location taking place at Jeffrey Street and NE 32nd Street, Boca Raton, FL 33487.

The City of Boca Raton is seeking \$1 million in federal appropriations to complete the replacement of critical municipal seawall infrastructure located at Jeffery Street on the Intracoastal Waterway and the eastern terminus of NE 32nd Street. The existing bulkheads at these street ends have severely deteriorated over the years and are no longer sufficient to prevent flooding during high tides and severe weather events. This vital coastal project aims to boost economic production, enhance resilience, protect East Boca residential neighborhoods and commercial districts, and safeguard public infrastructure against the increasing threats of sea-level rise and coastal erosion.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C.5305(a)(1).
