I am requesting \$3,000,000 in funding Broward College Lighting, Signage and in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Broward College located at 111 E. Las Olas Boulevard, Suite 33-522, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33301, with the project taking place at the North Campus of Broward College in Coconut Creek, FL South Campus in Pembroke Pines, FL and Central Campus in Davie, FL.

The project aims to enhance the safety, accessibility, and usability of Broward College's three campuses for students, faculty, staff, and community members by:

- Upgrading outdated lighting fixtures on North and South Campuses to modern, energy-efficient LED systems;
- Improving wayfinding and directional signage across all campuses; and
- Installing ADA-compliant signage, including braille, to ensure equitable navigation for visually impaired individuals..

It is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because it makes a critical public institution safer, more accessible, and better equipped to serve a large and growing community. Broward College plays a central role in educating the local workforce and supporting economic activity in one of the nation's most populous and economically productive counties.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(1), and 5305(a)(5).
