I am requesting \$1,200,000 in funding for NW 44th Street Safety Improvements in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Oakland Park, located at 1100 Park Lane East, Oakland Park, FL 33334 with the project location taking place at NW 44th Street from Middle River Canal East to NW 21st Avenue, Oakland Park, FL 33309.

The NW 44th Street Safety Improvements project aims to enhance roadway safety, reduce vehicle speeds, and improve mobility for all users along this critical neighborhood corridor in the City of Oakland Park. Traffic studies and extensive community engagement have identified excessive speeding and unsafe driving behaviors as major safety concerns, posing risks for motorists, pedestrians, bicyclists, and nearby residents. This project is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because it directly addresses roadway safety using proven, cost-effective strategies that prevent injuries and reduce long-term public costs. By slowing vehicle speeds and improving visibility through traffic calming measures, enhanced crossings, and clearer signage, the project lowers the likelihood and severity of crashes—protecting residents, students, and daily commuters who rely on NW 44th Street.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(1).
