
I am requesting \$1,500,000 in funding for Stormwater Drainage Outfall Rehabilitation Project at Pine Tree Estates Neighborhood in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Parkland located at 6600 University Drive, Parkland, FL 33067 with the project location taking place at Pine Tree Estates Neighborhood, Parkland, FL 33067.

The Stormwater Drainage Outfall Rehabilitation Project will rehabilitate critical drainage infrastructure in the Pine Tree Estates neighborhood of Parkland, Florida. The project addresses deteriorated outfalls that currently cannot manage stormwater effectively, reducing the risk of flooding during heavy rains and hurricanes. Improvements include repairing or replacing damaged structures and upgrading the system to ensure reliable stormwater management, protect public safety, and support neighborhood resilience and growth.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C.5305(a)(1).
