
I am requesting \$2,500,000 in funding for the West Copans Integrated Transit Control Center Phase 1 in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Broward County, located at 115 South Andrews Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33301 with the project location taking place at 3201 West Copans Road, Pompano Beach, FL 33069.

The purpose of the project is to implement an integrated control center (ICC) to serve all existing and planned future modes of transportation. This project will provide room and technology capabilities to accommodate communication, monitoring, and reporting needs for all transportation modes planned by the agency. The \$2.5 million requested will go towards design completion and pre-construction activities for the ICC which will be located within the existing West Copans Operations and Maintenance project site. This is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the ICC will serve as the central hub for monitoring, dispatching, and managing transit services across the region. The project also aligns with federal priorities for innovation, equity, and economic development. Situated within a Qualified Opportunity Zone, the ICC will anchor continued investment in the West Copans redevelopment area while supporting workforce development through its integration into a new, two-story training facility. This co-location fosters a pipeline of skilled transit professionals equipped to operate and manage next-generation transportation systems.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by chapter 53 of title 49 of the United States Code.
