All applicants who have submitted a “complete” application by Monday, October 26, 2026 at 5:00 PM are eligible for an interview with the Board. The Board is a panel of qualified experts who meet with each applicant and evaluate their readiness for the rigors of academy and military life.

Short Answer Questions:

Please submit your answers to all 4 of the following questions on a separate sheet of paper, typed, single-spaced, with a limit of one half (1/2) page per response.

1. Describe a situation where you were called on to lead others and how you conducted yourself.
2. Academy life is academically and physically rigorous, with limited personal time. Why do you wish to attend a service academy over a traditional school, and how have you prepared yourself for the demands that you will face if nominated and appointed?
3. Academy life is about the “we” not the “me”. Describe a time when you worked with others to achieve a shared goal.
4. Describe a situation where you failed at something, how you responded, and how that experience affected or changed you?
