I am requesting funding for ACFB Trucks to Serve Our Community in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Atlanta Community Food Bank, located at 3400 N. Desert Drive, Atlanta, GA 30344. The funding would fund the Atlanta Community Food Bank's (ACFB) purchase of four tractor trailers and six box trucks for the transport of nutritious food and grocery items. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the additional trucks will allow ACFB to serve food insecure communities more reliably, more frequently and more consistently. ACFB will be better equipped to assist agencies who serve families with limited to no access to healthy food options.
