I am requesting funding for a Fulton County Family Justice Center Survivor Empowerment Hub in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Fulton County, Georgia, located at 141 Pryor Street, Atlanta, GA 30303.

The funding would be used for the creation of a Survivor Empowerment Hub at the Fulton County Family Justice Center. At the Survivor Empowerment Hub, victims who have suffered from violence, abuse, humiliation, and neglect, may choose therapy for trauma, job assistance, food, clothing, and financial literacy, among other services.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the Family Justice Center Survivor Empowerment Hub will reduce violence and provide resources to survivors, becoming a resource for all citizens who live in and visit Fulton County.


The advantage of a Family Justice Center is that victims only have to go one place for all services; and providers in the Family Justice Center are working together to provide the services and supports victims need. Given the number of residents and visitors Fulton County sees daily, a Family Justice Center with Survivor Empowerment Hub will be a worthy investment for the community.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by section 501 of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10152).
