I am requesting funding for the Elk Ridge City Water Mainline Replacement Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Elk Ridge City located at 80 Park Dr, Elk Ridge, Utah 84651.

The funding would be used to replace aging and deteriorating water mainlines to improve system reliability, reduce water loss, and ensure consistent drinking water service for residents. The upgrades will strengthen system performance and improve water pressure, which is critical for fire suppression in a wildland-urban interface area. By modernizing essential infrastructure, the project will enhance public safety, conserve water resources, and support long-term community resilience.

The project has a federal nexus because authorized under the Safe Drinking Water Act (42 U.S.C. §300f et seq.), which authorizes federal assistance for public water systems to improve drinking water infrastructure and ensure reliable delivery of safe drinking water.
