Failure to replace the aging tank will result in deteriorating drinking water quality for the residents of Ephraim. Funding will help expedite the process of constructing a new water tank in this community of 6500 residents and secure access to drinking water quality and safety for years to come in an area where water is increasingly scarce.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized in Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
