Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Fairfield Town Park Community Facilities Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Fairfield Town, located at 43 S 75 W, Fairfield, UT 84013.

The funding would be used to construct a public-use pavilion and permanent restroom facility at Fairfield Town Park to support recreation and community use in a rural area of Utah's Fourth District. These improvements will provide essential infrastructure for safe, accessible gatherings, youth activities, and community events. Fairfield has secured significant local and county funding for broader park development, and this project will help ensure the park can function as a fully usable community asset.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the pavilion and restroom facilities will provide essential infrastructure for safe public use of the park and support community activities in a rural town with limited recreational amenities.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 7 U.S.C. 1926(a).
