Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Juab Special Service Fire District Ladder Fire Truck Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Juab Special Service Fire District, located at 160 North Main Street, Nephi, UT 84648.

The funding would be used to purchase a ladder fire truck to enhance emergency response and fire protection capabilities throughout Juab County. The District serves nearly 12,000 residents and requires this apparatus to effectively respond to structural fires and complex emergencies.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the District currently lacks adequate ladder apparatus capacity, limiting its ability to respond effectively to multi-story structures and complex emergency situations.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 7 U.S.C. 1926(a).
