Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Mt. Pleasant Fire Station Modernization Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Mt. Pleasant City, located at 115 W Main, Mt. Pleasant, UT 84647.

The funding would be used for the expansion of the Mt. Pleasant City fire station by adding three drive-through bays, a training area, and additional space for equipment. The current facility is overcrowded, with trucks parked bumper to bumper and limited room for personnel to access equipment safely. This project will improve emergency response capacity and provide adequate training and equipment space for firefighters serving Mt. Pleasant and surrounding rural areas of Sanpete County.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because failure to expand the Mt. Pleasant fire station will limit emergency response capacity and jeopardize the safety of residents and first responders.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 7 U.S.C. 1926(a).
