Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Woodland Hills Culinary Water Pipeline Replacement Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Woodland Hills City located at 690 S. Woodland Hills Drive, Woodland Hills, Utah 84653.

The funding would be used to replace approximately three miles of aging and failing culinary water pipelines in Woodland Hills City to improve system reliability, water quality, and fire protection capacity. The upgrades will replace undersized pipelines and associated infrastructure to meet current standards and ensure adequate water pressure for residential use and emergency response.

This project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act (42 U.S.C. § 300j-12), which supports projects that improve drinking water infrastructure to ensure safe, reliable, and adequate water supply for communities.
