Dear Chairwoman Granger and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Village of Beverly Hills Water Main and Service Line Replacement Project in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Village of Beverly Hills, MI located at 18500 W 13 Mile Beverly Hills, MI 48025.

The funding would be used for a water main and service line replacement project that would abandon approximately 18,000 ft. of 4-inch water main and construct approximately 8,200 ft. of new 8-inch main to complete and install 305 new 1" service leads. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it prioritizes and protects the public health of residents in Beverly Hills, Michigan by reducing the risk of lead levels in drinking water.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
