2. I am requesting funding for the Inglenook Park Accessibility, Safety and Aging Infrastructure Improvements project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is City of Southfield, located at 26000 Evergreen Road, PO 2055, Southfield, MI 48037.

This project focuses on improving accessibility, safety, and aging infrastructure at one of Southfield's most heavily used community parks. Located 21101 West Twelve on the south side of Twelve between Lasher and Evergreen Road, Inglenook Park is a 42.41-acre Community Park serving residents through organized sports, recreation, and nature-based activities. Amenities include an accessible parking lot with pervious pavers, restroom facilities, four ball fields, shade pavilion, accessible playground, picnic seating, safety lighting, a fitness trail, and open green space.

This project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because redevelopment of the park will expand access to outdoor recreation, strengthen neighborhood connections, support community wellness, and provide economic development.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
