1. **Proposed Recipient:** City of Garden City

Project Name: Garden City for Kathryn Watermain

Project Address: 6000 Middlebelt, Garden City, MI 48135

Amount Requested: \$ 860,000

Description of Project: The proposed replacement consists of 2200 lineal feet of 8" pipe bursting replacement. By replacing deteriorating water infrastructure, the project ensures the continued delivery of safe and reliable drinking water, reduces the risk of contamination from pipe failures, and maintains compliance with public health protection standards under the Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA).

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2. **Proposed Recipient:** Village of Beverly Hills

Project Name: Village of Beverly Hills for Water Main Improvements

Project Address: 18500 W. 13 Mile Rd, Beverly Hills, MI 48025

Amount Requested: \$ 1,000,000

Description of Project: The project will replace approximately 14,000 linear feet of aging water main, much of which was originally constructed prior to the 1940s and is experiencing an increasing frequency of water main breaks. The improvements will reduce system failures, minimize water loss, improve water quality, and ensure consistent service delivery to residents.

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3. **Proposed Recipient:** City of Dearborn Heights

Project Name: City of Dearborn Heights for Ecorse Creek Stormwater Treatment and Stream Restoration

Project Address: 6045 Fenton St., Dearborn Heights, MI 48127

Amount Requested: \$ 2,400,000

Description of Project: This project will restore a degraded section of the creek, stabilizing its banks and installing natural stormwater treatment infrastructure. The intended impact is to reduce the pollutants flowing downstream and improve water quality overall.

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4. **Proposed Recipient:** Great Lakes Water Authority

Project Name: Dearborn Transmission Main Condition Assessment & Renewals

Project Address: The location of this project varies. Renewals of these transmission mains will occur throughout the City of Dearborn and portions of the City of Detroit.

Amount Requested: \$ 5,000,000

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Description of Project: This project consists of the inspection and potential renewal of 18 miles of drinking water transmission mains located in the City of Dearborn and portions near the city in the City of Detroit in Wayne County, Michigan.

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5. **Proposed Recipient:** Redford Charter Township

Project Name: Redford Township for Lead Service Line Replacement Project – Phase V

Project Address: 15145 Beech Daly Road, Redford Township, MI 48239

Amount Requested: \$ 2,000,000

Description of Project: Redford Charter Township is requesting funding for Phase V of this long-term project to monitor and replace lead services lines to ensure safe drinking water.

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6. **Proposed Recipient:** City of Lathrup Village

Project Name: City of Lathrup Village for Lathrup Boulevard Water Main Replacement

Project Address: Lathrup Boulevard - San Quentin to 12 Mile Road

Amount Requested: \$ 1,412,000

Description of Project: This project will replace approximately 4,100 linear feet of nearly 100-year-old cast-iron water main along Lathrup Boulevard in Lathrup Village, located in Michigan's 12th Congressional District.

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7. **Proposed Recipient:** Third Judicial Circuit of Michigan

Project Name: Juvenile Drug Treatment Court - STAND Program

Project Address: 1025 E. Forest Ave, Detroit, MI 48207

Amount Requested: \$ 3,500,000

Description of Project: The Supervised Treatment for Alcohol and Narcotic Dependency (STAND) Program is a Wayne County Juvenile Drug Treatment Court (JDTC) that serves non-violent youth involved in the juvenile justice system who have been identified with a substance use disorder. The program operates through a collaborative partnership where participants receive access to a comprehensive continuum of services, including substance use treatment, family therapy, parent support groups, tutoring, mentoring, and transportation assistance.

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8. **Proposed Recipient:** City of Dearborn Heights

Project Name: Dearborn Heights Dispatch Center

Project Address: 6045 Fenton St., Dearborn Heights, MI 48127

Amount Requested: \$ 1,936,250

Description of Project: This project will modernize the City's dispatch infrastructure by replacing aging hardware and software. These improvements will allow dispatchers to process calls faster, give more accurate information to responders in the field, and integrate technologies with digital evidence systems.

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9. **Proposed Recipient:** City of Detroit

Project Name: City of Detroit Accessibility Repairs and Home Improvements

Project Address: Detroit segment of the 12th Congressional District, Zip Codes 48228 and 48204

Amount Requested: \$5,000,000

Description of Project: The City of Detroit is requesting funding to implement a city-wide accessibility program providing home modifications for residents with documented disabilities. The initiative emphasizes “Aging in Place” with specific resource allocation to support seniors (62+) in maintaining independence through home safety and accessibility retrofits.

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10. **Proposed Recipient:** Detroit Public Schools Community District

Project Name: Detroit Public Schools Community District High School Workforce Development Initiative

Project Address: Cody High School, Henry Ford High School, and Mumford High School

Amount Requested: \$4,000,000

Description of Project: The funding would be used to support building out the infrastructure for neighborhood high schools to function as robust workforce development spaces, ensuring that students can pursue rigorous academics while preparing for high-demand careers.

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11. **Proposed Recipient:** Wayne County

Project Name: Wayne County Home Repair

Project Address: Projects will be located within Congressional District 12, Zip Codes 48217 and 48229

Amount Requested: \$2,000,000

Description of Project: The funding would be used to administer a home repair program in Wayne County. The home repair services will ensure safe, affordable housing plus leverage federal Home Weatherization Program funds. The project will improve over 100 homes in Wayne County’s 12th congressional district.

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12. **Proposed Recipient:** City of Detroit

Project Name: City of Detroit Mold Remediation Program

Project Address: Projects will be located within Congressional District 12, Zip Codes 48228 and 48204

Amount Requested: \$5,000,000

Description of Project: The project will conduct targeted household mold remediation in Detroit neighborhoods where poverty, asthma disparities, and flood-related basement water damage most overlap, focusing on homes impacted by the federally declared June 2021 and August 2023 storm and flooding disasters.

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13. Proposed Recipient: City of Dearborn

Project Name: City of Dearborn Senior Public Housing Modernization and Life-Safety Upgrades

Project Address: 22077 Beech Street Dearborn, MI 48124 and 5500 Calhoun Street Dearborn, MI 48126

Amount Requested: \$7,256,470

Description of Project: The City of Dearborn is requesting federal funding to modernize critical infrastructure and life-safety systems at two City-owned senior public housing towers: John B. O'Reilly Jr. Manor and Suzanne Sareini Manor. Constructed in 1976 and 1977, these buildings provide 329 housing units for seniors aged 55 and older as well as residents with disabilities. Many of the mechanical and safety systems in these buildings have reached the end of their useful life and require replacement to ensure reliable building operations and safe living conditions.

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14. Proposed Recipient: Detroit Public Schools Community District

Project Name: Detroit Public Schools Community District Bennet Elementary School Renovation

Project Address: 2111 Mullane Street, Detroit, MI 48209

Amount Requested: \$1,000,000

Description of Project: This project will implement comprehensive building improvements, including a new roof, energy-efficient window replacements, upgraded doors, and renovation of the school's auditorium, a central space used for student performances, assemblies, family engagement, and community gatherings.

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15. Proposed Recipient: City of Westland

Project Name: City of Westland Fire Station No. 4, Equipment Acquisition and Outfitting

Project Address: 37200 Palmer Road, Westland, MI 48186

Amount Requested: \$1,000,000

Description of Project: The City of Westland seeks federal funding to acquire essential, one-time capital equipment and station outfitting necessary to fully activate the new Fire Station No. 4 and support safe, timely emergency response.

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16. Proposed Recipient: City of Livonia

Project Name: Bennett Civic Center Library Phase II ADA-accessible Restroom Renovation

Amount Requested: \$1,200,000

Description of Project: Phase II of the ADA-accessible restroom renovation project will renovate the remaining public and staff restrooms on all three floors of the Bennett Civic Center Library to ensure they meet current ADA standards. Currently, the library does not have any ADA-accessible restrooms, which prevents some patrons from visiting or fully utilizing the facility.

Amount Requested: \$2,000,000

Description of Project: The building safety and system improvements will ensure access to the childcare center which provides free services to 123 children and wrap-around family support. The childcare center needs infrastructure improvements, including HVAC, roof, and window maintenance, to continue operations.

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18. Proposed Recipient: City of Dearborn

Project Name: City of Dearborn Civic Center Expansion

Project Address: 15801 Michigan Avenue, Dearborn, MI 48126

Amount Requested: \$5,000,000

Description of Project: This project will support critical infrastructure enhancements and the construction of multi-purpose recreational spaces designed to alleviate existing capacity constraints and allow the facility to better serve youth athletic programs, community leagues, and regional events.

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19. Proposed Recipient: City of Inkster

Project Name: City of Inkster New Construction Fire House

Project Address: 27717 Michigan Ave., Inkster, MI 48141

Amount Requested: \$3,500,000

Description of Project: The City of Inkster is seeking funding to support the construction of a new fire station, a critical public safety investment. Inkster currently operates with a single fire station that serves the entire city, and the existing facility is aging, deteriorating, and no longer adequate to meet the operational needs of a modern fire department.

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20. Proposed Recipient: City of Southfield

Project Name: Inglenook Park Accessibility, Safety and Aging Infrastructure Improvements

Amount Requested: \$2,110,000

Description of Project: This project focuses on improving accessibility, safety, and aging infrastructure at one of Southfield's most heavily used community parks. Due to age and heavy use, several key amenities need improvement.

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
